Tallahassee News by Janice Gargus

One of our favorite rides is to historic Pelham, Georgia. Through winding roads and farm lands, we travel from Tallahassee to a small southwest town. In this town is the historic Hand Trading Company. Anchoring one of the bottom floors in the corner end of this 4 story building is a Mennonite Restaurant with good home made food, salads and their famous desserts.

The town was incorporated in 1881 and named in honor of Major John Pelham, who was killed during the Civil War at the Battle of Kelly's Ford in Virginia in 1863. According to the 2010 U.S. census, the population was 3,898.

Pelham became an agricultural and commercial stronghold during the early twentieth century, due in large part to the presence of a towering, retail emporium called the Hand Trading Company, which occupied a four-story building in the heart of downtown. In 1914 Judson Hand—the father of Virginia Hand, who would marry Cason Callaway of Callaway Gardens fame —began building the store following his visit to the Marshall Field's Depart-

The Hand store featured a huge decorated dome, 100 columns, and nearly 100,000 square feet of floor space. It was the ultimate all-purpose superstore, offering a wide range of products from groceries and dry goods to tractors and other large farm equipment. The store closed in 1984, and the building remains one of the city's most popular historic attractions.

This beautiful four-story Historical building once called the "Big Store" carrying a variety of goods for sale has now been adapted for new uses.
